### WHO WE ARE?

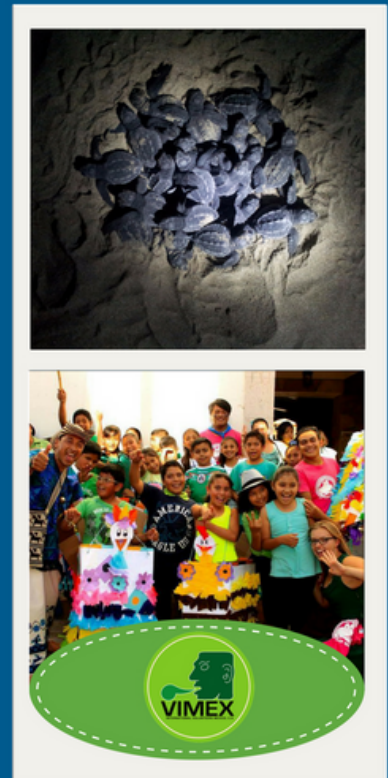
We are a non-governmental, non-religious, non-profit or political organization founded in Mexico because of the 1985 earthquake with the purpose of helping those affected.

## PROPOSED ACTIVITIES (AT VIMEX):

### **Office activities:**

- Communication and administration: support the preparation of documents (letters, spreadsheets, emails).
- Answer calls and e-mails. Giving information to (future) volunteers
- informative talks.
- Supporting VIMEX: The first step to start the workcamps season is to prepare a detailed programme with all the information from the local partners (member organisations) to provide to the international partners in the Technical Meeting, the annual meeting of our international network ALLIANCE.
- The volunteer will be in charge of keeping web contents like Facebook, Twitter and other social media up-to-date. This consists in finding relevant information and communicating it to the audience.

### **Specialized work:**

- With a Human Rights organisation. Raising awareness, organizing events, preparation of material, networking.
- Time dedicated to parallel activities: brain storming, group work, development of ideas, organizing the activities (events, meeting), performing the initiatives in the territory schools, municipalities, other organizations) to raise awareness about the situation of migrants and foster the role of youth as promoters of intercultural dialogue.

## GENERAL CONDITIONS

The future volunteer will have a five days preparation seminar before starting the EVS to learn more about the project and the country.

The work will be 8 hours a day and the weekends will be free.

The volunteer will be hosted by a Mexican family in Mexico City.

The volunteer must be +21 years old and have at least 40% Spanish skills.
