Description of the local community of the project:

How was the beginning?

"Not to complain more and do something for others" A group of friends who united by the desire to help, we come together to transform the reality of children from different places in the South Zone. It was a new world to be discovered for everyone, and that desire pushed us, day by day, to take on new challenges. It sounds ironic to fight for a plate of food every day, for shelter and for love, but precisely because we believe that our dream is achievable, we decided to get down to work and start this beautiful project with the soul, with desire, with will, effort and above all With conviction and love. We collaborate with canteens, snack bars, health rooms, kindergartens, schools, development societies and cultural societies of Banfield and Lomas de Zamora; Where in addition to covering basic needs, we encourage school support and emotional restraint. A little bit they were added volunteers who disinterestedly committed to the cause. It was in 2008 when we arrived at "Los ángeles nos miran", a picnic area of Villa Independencia, which we renovated and added as our first venue, incorporating daily snacks and various recreational tasks. Then came "The shelter of children", whom we supported from the outset to reopen its doors. This was how we added lunch to the picnic at Villa Benquez and improved its infrastructure. While all this was happening, the desire of an own dining room, made from scratch, began to materialize and then give rise to the third headquarters of South Solidario: "Las Tejedoras". It was the year 2011 and the growth of our mission was incessant; We raise our fourth so-called "Green Bridge" located in the neighborhood of El Progreso de Lomas de Zamora. Sur Solidario works daily for the maintenance of all its venues, where besides satisfying the basic needs of every human being, it offers school support and different recreational and office workshops. We combine the growth of each child to facilitate their evolution and that they can continue with studies. In turn, we seek to be able to insert themselves without inconvenience in the labor system.

Role of each volunteer and the planned tasks for the volunteer (work schedule):

Volunteer's tasks:

*Work together with another volunteer in a pedagogical duo.

*Help in the daily activities, preparing the merienda, giving school support, playing with the kids and organizing some educational, recreational and art workshops. Be ready to share your skills and interests with the kids.

The activities are taking place during the afternoon. Be flexible to participate in Saturdays activities of the organization because during weekend they generally provide



lunch and organize some activities.

Volunteers will have weekly meetings to discuss various topics in order to understand and complement their social intervention as volunteers. Besides, we aim to provide them with a complete social, historical, political and economic background. There will be solidarity activities planned for all the volunteers to have common interexchanges, like festivals, workshops in schools, etc.

The volunteer will helpo in one of the daily centres (merenderos) and he will support the communication area taking photos of the activities of the organization in all the centres. SO the volunteer should be ready to work with children in one place but also to visit every event of the organization, the different centres and to go to the administrative centre.
