ABOUT BIOART LABORATORIES

BioArt Laboratories is an international orientated non-profit foundation focused on the Bio Arts, where we orientate on sustainability, innovation and the environment. We are located in the south of the Netherlands in the city called Eindhoven, and are housed in formal monumental bunkers that look like farmhouses.

We have various farm animals at BioArt Laboratories that are an important element in our storytelling of our main research line: that the human habitat can coexist in a balanced way with the natural ecological habitat.

We are currently looking for volunteers who are interested in helping the organization with the daily outdoor practices and are interested in learning more about sustainable living on an offgrid location. Volunteers learn how to live with a sustainable, off-grid mindset close to nature, while working hands-on with the daily activities of the organization. These consists of animal care with hobby farm animals such as 2 cows, alot of chickens, three ponies, two pigs, three geese and birds; helping out in the green/maintaining the forest area; and various renovation related tasks as we restore an old, monumental bunker into a cultural development place, like painting, woodworking and plastering. The perfect profile would be volunteers that have affinity with rural activities, have a practical mentality, prefer to experience living in nature as a way of life

When applying, please take note of the type of activities and their outdoor nature (can be wet, cold, and muddy while feeding/cleaning/taking care of animals.



PARTICIPANT PROFILE

If you are accustomed to luxurity or always want to be connected to the internet 24/7, then this is not the project for you. This project is for people who are interested in trying something new and refreshing, or want to learn to live off-grid with a sustainable mindset in a nature rich environment. We have adjusted the facilities to help you with developing that mindset.

Your stay will be in one of the buildings that we have renovated, and you have your own sleeping room. The kitchen area, living area, and other facilities are shared spaces, so some experience / discipline of living with shared living area's, as well some knowledge of cooking, is recommended.

CONDITIONS

Accommodation - all the volunteers will be hosted in BioArt Village, which is 20 - 25 minutes cycling to the city centre of Eindhoven or to the local marketplace.

Travel budget - the amount depends on the distance between your home city to Eindhoven, established by the EU Distance Calculator platform.

You receive food money along with pocketmoney and its paid out every two weeks in advance after arrival. It is important that you have arranged a valid bank account prior to your arrival with a valid International Bank Account Number.

We start at 9:00 in the morning, have a break of 30 minutes in the midday, and end our day at 17:00. After 17:00 and during the weekends, you are free to explore Eindhoven and the Netherlands!



You have two off-days a month besides the weekend, that you can request in advance.

Health insurance - each volunteer will be registered for the free medical insurance of the ESC program called Henner. In case you have access to an European Health Insurance Card (EHIC), you can bring that with you.

Language - You have a basic understanding of English (A2 level recommended).

Youth Pass Certificate - at the end of the mobility each volunteer will receive his/her personal official certificate!

You need to be commited to the daily activities in your best capacity, and able to communicate.



- Age between 18 30 years.
- You are coming from an EU country. or from Partner Countries according to the European Solidarity Corps.
- You didn't do a long term EVS / ESC project before that is more than 2 months. You must be able to commit to the activities as stated.
- You have a VISA or have a double nationality with one of them EU.

The standard time period are either short term (59 days) or 3 to 6 months, depending on eligability / VISA. The volunteering places are really wanted, so make sure you follow each step with a complete registration and meet the criteria. We will stay in contact first by email and after by WhatsApp being faster and more personal so please be sure that you have the app on your mobile number given.

- You are motivated, open-minded and pro-active.
- You are aware that you will step out of your comfort zone and are able to do it.
- You respect the rules, structure and practices of the hosting organisation. Since we host various art projects and visitors, we are also obliged to uphold the privacy of them. As such, its not possible to record or document your stay for social media and such.



From BioArt Laboratories you can go to various places, such as the market in Eindhoven, Eindhoven Central or the Klokgebouw. All these locations are within cycling distance.
